

Summer Music Study & Jam Camp Scholarships

Rules & Regulations-please read carefully

General Information-Summer Music Study AND Jam Camp Applicants

The Ohio Music Teachers Association Central East District, CEOhioMTA, is pleased to offer scholarships to eligible students. The goal of the scholarship is to broaden the student’s exposure to music through something outside the regular routine. Scholarships are sponsored by both local businesses and the CEOhioMTA and range from \$100 to the \$700 Graduating Senior Award (used for tuition reimbursement for students majoring in music).

Summer Music Study Scholarships may be used to pay for a music camp (excluding Jam Camp), master class, workshop, institute, special lessons, or coaching, separate from study with the teacher of current enrollment (the scholarship award should not benefit the current teacher of study or relatives of the student’s teacher). If you would like to use an awarded scholarship for something other than listed above, the teacher must contact the chairperson for prior approval—before submitting the application.

Jam Camp Scholarships must be used to attend Jam Camp sponsored by CEOhioMTA.

Application Process – Summer Music Study AND Jam Camp Applicants

1. Teacher fills out Application for both scholarship applicants
2. Teacher fills out Judges Score Sheet highlighted areas for Summer Music Study Applicants.
3. Student writes essay according to Student Essay Guidelines-see application for specific requirements for essay content.
4. Teacher submits all materials, self-addressed stamped envelopes, and payment in one packet to Registrar postmarked by the deadline.
5. Audition times for Summer Music Study applicants will be mailed in one of the envelopes provided approximately two weeks before the audition date.

Applications missing any components will not be accepted

Applications mailed after the postmark deadline will not be accepted

Registration fees are not refundable

Basis of Awards -Summer Music Study

Applicants will be judged based on the following areas:

Performance (50%)

Essay (30%)

Sight-reading (20%)

Eligibility – Summer Music Study

1. The auditions are open to students of Central East District OhioMTA members as well as nonmembers; however, students and non-member teachers are required to reside within the Central East District.
2. Applicants must have studied in the performance medium of the audition with their current teacher for at least six (6) months of the nine (9) months immediately preceding the auditions.
3. Previous recipients are not eligible to audition the year following their award, with the exception of future music majors auditioning for the Graduating Senior Award for rising music majors.
4. A student may compete on more than one instrument but cannot win more than one scholarship.
5. Students may apply for a Summer Music Study Scholarship **OR** a Jam Camp Scholarship, but not both.
6. A teacher may enter no more than three Summer Music Study applications and two Jam Camp applications.
7. Scholarship awards may not financially benefit the student's teacher or relatives of the student's teacher.

Division and Performance Length-Summer Music Study

Elementary (ages 9 to 11) – 3 to 6 minutes

Junior High (ages 12 to 14) – 6 to 10 minutes

Senior High (ages 15 +) – 10 to 20 minutes

Repertoire Requirements -Summer Music Study

1. Two or three selections from ***different*** compositional eras should be prepared.
2. Pianists and vocalists must perform from memory - memorization is optional for all other instrumentalists.
3. Performance of prepared selections will be followed by sight-reading.
4. Students may enter up to three pieces to meet the time requirement. However, actual audition length may be reduced depending upon the number of applicants and/or time limitations on the day of auditions.

Auditions – Summer Music Study

1. Accompaniment for non-piano auditions is recommended, but not required. An accompanist may not be the student's teacher or parent.
2. Auditions are closed. To assure anonymity, teachers may not assist students in any manner, nor identify themselves to the judges. Instrumentalists are expected to tune their own instruments.
3. All students will perform in person on the day of the auditions. No recorded auditions or deferred auditions are possible.

Award Distribution/Notification – Summer Music Study

1. Notification of the results will be mailed in one of the self-addressed stamped envelopes provided with the application within seven (7) to ten (10) days of the event.
2. Comment sheets from judges will be returned with the results in one of the envelopes provided with application.
3. Award money must be used during the summer of the year in which it is awarded and cannot be deferred to the fall or to another year. (with the exception of the Graduating Senior Award)
4. Payment of the awards will be made directly to the institution sponsoring the camp, workshop, etc. *Winners must contact the scholarship chairman in writing by **June 30th** (via mail or e-mail) regarding the direction of funds.*
5. *Scholarship awards may not financially benefit the student's teacher or relatives of the student's teacher.*

Honors Recital – Summer Music Study Winners *only*

1. Scholarship recipients are expected to perform at the **CEOhioMTA Honors Recital**.
2. Teachers of scholarship recipients must contact the Chairperson of Student Recitals to enroll their students in the Honors Recital. See www.ceomta.org, heading "Student Events/Student Solo & Ensemble Recitals" for details.

Basis of Awards -Jam Camp

Applicants will be judged based on 100% of their essay-see application for specific requirements for essay content.

Eligibility – Jam Camp

1. The application is open to students of Central East District OhioMTA members as well as nonmembers; however, students and non-member teachers are required to reside within the Central East District.
2. Students must be a least six (6) years of age by the day of camp and have had at least six (6) months of formal lessons prior to the day of camp.
3. Previous recipients are not eligible to audition the year following their award.
4. Students may apply for a Summer Music Study Scholarship **OR** a Jam Camp Scholarship, but not both.
5. A teacher may enter no more than two Jam Camp applications and three Summer Music Study applications.
6. Scholarship awards may not financially benefit the student's teacher or relatives of the student's teacher, this does not apply to teachers participating in the Jam Camp program.

Division (no Performance is required for application) -Jam Camp Applicants only

Beginning (Less than two years of study)

Intermediate (2-5 years study of study)

Advanced (6 or more years of study)

Award Distribution/Notification – Jam Camp

1. Notification of the results will be e-mailed to the applicants seven (7) to ten (10) days after April 6, 2019. Please be sure e-mail address is legible on application.
2. Award money must be used during the summer of the year in which it is awarded and cannot be deferred to another year.
3. Payment of the awards will be made directly to Jam Camp.

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
