## Copyright Representation and Indemnification Agreement for Use of Downloaded/Computer-Generated Music

This is an agreement between the undersigned teacher and student (or legal guardian if not 18 years old) (hereinafter “you”), and the Central East District of the Ohio Music Teachers Association. In consideration of the Central East District of the OhioMTA granting the Student the opportunity to participate in the event for which you are applying, you agree as follows:

You represent and warrant that, with regard to the sheet music you intend to use in the event: (i) you obtained a license to use the reproduced sheet music, (ii) you otherwise have the right to use the reproduced sheet music, or (iii) the reproduced sheet music is in the public domain.

You agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Central East District of the Ohio Music Teachers Association from and against any and all claims, liabilities, obligations, injuries, damages, or other losses (including taxes and related penalties if applicable), and any related costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys’ fees and disbursements and costs of investigation, litigation, settlement judgment, appeal, interest, fines and penalties) arising from a breach of this Agreement.
