

Pianorama 2025 Conductor Notes for Level 3A

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I am thrilled to lead this group! We will be performing some enjoyable pieces. Please number your measures (both primo and secondo), and write in the comments below.

Star Wars Main Theme mm qtr note = 96



Everyone recognizes this piece as the first four notes are played. Make sure triplets are steady and even. Melody should be legato

Primo turns the page. Measures 15-16 keep the eight notes even and connected

Secondo holds chords - they are not staccato. Measures 5-8 and 21-23 play bass line legato



Over the Rainbow mm qtr note = 92

This is another piece that people know well. Bring out the melody when you play it. This piece is very expressive, so work on dynamics.

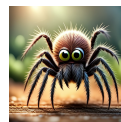
Primo turns the page with Left Hand (don't worry about playing the LH notes) in measure 27. You will turn the next page as well.

Secondo -add a crescendo on beat 3 of measure 2; measure 3 will be mezzo piano; measure 4 diminuendo (not crescendo); measure 5 will be p (not mp). Measure 22- mark mp (not mf)

All - add poco crescendo to measure 15 and 31. Mark "watch" in measure 35, as there will be a ritardando from measure 35-37.

Primo RH and *Secondo* LH are using some of the same keys within four beats, so hold your note for its full length, then move. Don't be a key hog!

Tarantella Spiritoso mm dotted qtr = 104



This piece will be conducted with 2 main beats per measure

Primo Light LH1 needed in measures 5-7, etc (no staccato). Turn the page - *secondo* will memorize measures 21-22 so you can play measure 20.

Measure 28 Fingering for the RH: RH 2 on the second A (cross out the 1); RH 3 plays the F# (this is a D Major scale fingering that is used in measures 44 and 65-67)

Secondo Memorize measures 21-22, as primo will turn the page after playing measure 20. Rests are super important throughout the piece

Festivale mm qtr note = 144



Stay close to the keys when clapping

Primo turns the page while playing the scale in measure 16
